

Nicolet Law "Suite Giveaway" Official Sweepstakes Rules

NO PURCHASE, PAYMENT OR DONATION OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES. A PURCHASE, PAYMENT OR DONATION WILL NOT INCREASE OR IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

1. ELIGIBILITY. NICOLET LAW "Suite Giveaway" (the "Sweepstakes") is only open to entrants who, as of the entry date, are permanent legal residents of the State of Minnesota who are at least eighteen (18) years old. The Sweepstakes is void outside the State of Minnesota or where prohibited or restricted by law. Employees, officers and directors of Minnesota Wild Hockey Club, L.P. ("Wild") and NICOLET LAW OFFICE, S.C. ("Sponsor") (Wild and Sponsor collectively the "Sweepstakes Entities"), their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, advertising and promotion agencies, and the immediate families (defined as parents, spouses, children, siblings, grandparents, and their respective spouses), or members of the same household (whether related or not) of each such employee, officer and director, are not eligible to enter. The Sweepstakes, and any website pages and advertisements relating thereto, is intended for viewing only within the eligible Sweepstakes territory, and entrants must be present in the eligible Sweepstakes territory at the time they enter.

2. TIMING. The Sweepstakes entry period begins at 9:00am Central Time ("CT") on March 1, 2026, and ends at 12:00pm CT on March 14, 2026 (the "Entry Period"). Wild's computer is the official timekeeping device for the Sweepstakes.

3. HOW TO ENTER. There are two (2) ways to enter the Sweepstakes:

- a. **TO ENTER ON WILD.COM:** Entrants may visit <https://www.nhl.com/wild/fans/contests> at any time during the Entry Period and enter to win by fully completing and submitting the provided form to receive one (1) entry. All eligible entries submitted during the Entry Period will be entered into a random drawing and eligible to win the prize (described in Section 6 below).
- b. **TO ENTER VIA MAIL:** LIMIT: One (1) mail in entry per person and address (physical or email) in the Sweepstakes. All entries must be received by the Wild during the Entry Period and become the exclusive property of the Wild. All entrants and entries are subject to verification prior to the awarding of a prize, as are the eligibility, age and other claims of/information provided by a potential prize winner. All entries must be sent via a self-addressed postage-stamped envelope to "NICOLET LAW "Suite Giveaway" – Mail-in Entry," Minnesota Wild, 317 Washington St., St. Paul, Minnesota 55102.

FOR ALL ENTRIES: LIMIT: One (1) entry per person or address (physical or email), per home game during the Sweepstakes. All entries must be received by Wild during the applicable Entry Period. Additional entries received from the same person in excess of the stated limitation for the Entry Period will be void. Standard text messaging rates and service use charges imposed by your cellular provider will apply and are the sole responsibility of the entrant. All entries become the exclusive property of the Sweepstakes Entities and none will be acknowledged or returned. All entrants and entries subject to verification prior to the awarding of a prize, as are the eligibility, age and other claims of/information provided by a potential prize winner.

4. AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES AND DECISIONS. By participating in the Sweepstakes, each entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to be bound by and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of the Sweepstakes Entities (including, without limitation, decisions regarding eligibility of entries, the selection of entrants and the winners, and the awarding of prizes), which are final and binding in all respects.

5. SELECTION; ODDS; NOTIFICATION. On or about March 14, 2026, the Sweepstakes Entities, in their sole discretion, will select nine (9) winner(s) from among all eligible entries received. Odds of being selected depend on the number of eligible entries received by the Wild during the Sweepstakes. The winner(s) selected must comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. The winner(s) will be notified by phone and may be required to execute and return to the Wild a notarized Affidavit of Eligibility, a Liability Release, and a Publicity Release (except where prohibited by law) (an "Affidavit/Release") in the form(s) provided by Wild in order to claim their prize. The Affidavit/Release must be returned to Wild by the date and/or time indicated within the Affidavit/Release. If the winner(s) cannot be contacted within one (1) day of the first attempt to contact them, then that winner may be disqualified and an alternate winner will be selected by the Sweepstakes Entities from all eligible non-winning entries received by the Sweepstakes Entities during the Sweepstakes.

6. PRIZE. Subject to the terms and conditions of these Official Rules,

One (1) prize will be awarded in this Sweepstakes to nine (9) winners. The Prize includes, and is limited to, two (2) suite tickets to the Minnesota Wild vs. Toronto Maple Leafs game on March 15, 2026. The approximate retail value ("ARV") of this prize is six hundred dollars (\$600).

Any costs not specifically noted above Section 6 will be the responsibility of each prize winner, including but not limited to, any costs associated with parking and travel to and from the Grand Casino Arena in St. Paul, Minnesota.

All prizes must be accepted as awarded, and prize is awarded "AS IS" with no warranty, representation, or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, made by Sweepstakes Entities or for which Sweepstakes Entities shall be liable, including, without limitation, ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, NON-INFRINGEMENT OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. No substitution, assignment, refund or transfer of a prize is permitted, except by Sweepstakes Entities, who reserve the right to substitute a prize (or a component thereof) with another prize (or component thereof) of greater or equal value, including cash, if a prize is not available for any reason as determined by a Sweepstakes Entity in its sole discretion. Winner is solely responsible for any and all costs, fees, taxes and expenses associated with prize award, receipt and use, including, without limitation, all federal, state and local taxes on the prize and any travel costs that may be incurred.

8. GENERAL CONDITIONS. Sweepstakes Entities reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate, modify or suspend the Sweepstakes if, in their opinion, there is any suspected or actual evidence of electronic or non-electronic tampering with any portion of the Sweepstakes, or if viruses, bugs, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical difficulties or failures or any other factor beyond Sweepstakes Entities' reasonable control corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Sweepstakes. In such event, Sweepstakes Entities reserve the right (but do not have the obligation) in their sole discretion to award prizes at random from among eligible, non-suspect entries received up to the time of suspected impairment. Sweepstakes Entities reserve the right in their sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. 11. DISPUTES. You may "opt-out" of receiving such marketing or promotional communications by stating on your entry form that you do not desire to receive such communications. Consenting to receive such emails and information (by not "opting out" or by "opting in") is optional and is not necessary to enter or win this Sweepstakes, nor will it increase or improve your chances of winning.
