"Minnesota Wild – Sheboygan Sausages Wild Sweepstakes" Official Rules

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES.

- 1. ELIGIBILITY. The Minnesota Wild and American Foods Group, LLC "Minnesota Wild Sheboygan Sausage Wild Sweepstakes" (the "Sweepstakes") is only open to entrants who, as of the entry date, are permanent legal residents of the United States who are at least eighteen (18) years old. The Sweepstakes is void outside of the states of Minnesota, Wisconsin, North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa and where prohibited or restricted by law.  - (2) **TO ENTER VIA MAIL:** LIMIT: One (1) mail-in entry per person and address (physical or email) in the Sweepstakes. - b. COMPLIANCE WITH OFFICIAL RULES: Failure to submit all required information in the manner required in these Official Rules may result in disqualification. Entries will not be acknowledged or returned. Proof of submission will not be deemed to be proof of receipt by Wild. Any submission that does not comply with any aspect of these Official Rules may be rejected by the Wild and the entrant disqualified.
- **4.
